This gives parishioners the option of either an earlier Mass each day at 9am or a slightly later time at 9.30 am and 10am on Saturdays. Naturally, this is not set in stone, and we will see how it works out over the coming weeks. It is likely that Father will also say one of the Sunday Masses each weekend, although we will alternate those Masses. Please make Father welcome when you see him. It will be very good to have him with us in Accrington after his long and faithful service to the Diocese as a Parish Priest.

**Bingo** as usual in St Anne's this Friday 15th February at 7pm.

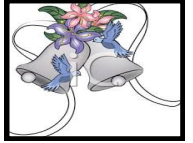


### **Choir Practice**
