**INCOME:** The total Sunday collections for Our Lady & St. Hubert with St. Wulstan came to £1,028.54 (less the diocesan levy of £281.93) the total collection is reduced to **£746.61**. Thank You.

**OUR PARISH LEVY:** It is I feel, worth reminding the parish that the joint Parish levy mentioned in this week's newsletter reflects the amount of money, withdrawn from our parish by the diocese, which helps pay for and support our schools and retired clergy along with the Bishop's Administration. Presently is set at **£14,660.00** per annum (£3,665.00 Our Lady & St. Hubert with St. Wulstan each and **EVERY** quarter). That is roughly about **£281.93** of our weekly collection that is already spoken for by the diocese. So when you read our week's **TOTAL** collection, you are fully aware of the actual amount we have received and then the amount remaining for that particular week to pay for and run the parish properties along with helping to maintain a resident Parish Priest.

**WEEKDAY MASS TIMES AND CONFESSION:** As I hope you know I do actually listen to advice given to me, and it appears that Weekday Mass at St. Hubert's would be best celebrated on a Friday and not on a Thursday morning, which would also enable the cleaning rotas to be continued. Therefore as of this coming week Mass will be celebrated on Monday & Thursdays at St. Wulstan's, Tuesdays at St. Mary's and Fridays at St. Hubert's. **Regarding Confession:** another good suggestion is to have confessions at St. Hubert's on Friday morning **AFTER** Mass. In order to allow for this I will require the Confessional to be made ready, so at this moment in time Confessions will be on request basis at St. Hubert's and St. Wulstan's. The Confession slot at St. Mary's on Saturday evening at 4.30 p.m. prior to the 5.00 p.m. Vigil Mass I will adopt.
